


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Bureau Fort Apache Agency has formerly transferred four BIA quarters to the Tribe and that formal acceptance by the Tribe of the transfer is necessary to finalize tribal ownership of the homes; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council that the four BIA dwellings be accepted by the Tribal Council and the Tribal Council concurs in said recommendation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the transfer of ownership from the Bureau of Indian Affairs of four Agency dwellings to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
