

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes that it has been at least two fiscal years since tribal employees have received cost of living salary increases; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to show its appreciation to the hard working and dedicated tribal employees who have performed their jobs diligently and loyally for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of these employees, the Tribal Council believes that a one time salary adjustment effective November 24, 1986, is more than appropriate at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council upon review of the various enterprises and tribal departments, concludes that the Fort Apache Timber Company employees should be excluded because they already received a salary adjustment in May of 1986, and that employees of departments funded by Grants and Contracts are eligible to receive a salary adjustment, subject to the availability of monies in their grants or contracts; and

WHEREAS, all other tribal enterprise employees shall receive this one time salary adjustment as follows:

A 6% increase for salaries up to \$25,000 and a 3% increase for salaries of \$25,000.01 or more, to be effective November 24, 1986.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a one time salary adjustment for all tribal enterprise and department employees, with the exception of FATCO and all employees of departments funded by Grants and Contracts, subject to the availability of grant monies for said salary adjustment, as follows:

A 6% increase for all tribal employees with annual incomes up to \$25,000, and a 3% increase for all tribal employees earning \$25,000.01 and more, both salary adjustments to be effective November 24, 1986.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
