

Resolution No. 86-395

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, passage of the FY 86/87 Tribal Budget and reorganization of the Tribal Government resulted in a reduction-in-force; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that personnel who were laid-off as a result of the FY 86/87 Budget in order to eliminate duplicative and superfluous job positions, shall be given preferences for new positions that are available within the tribal government and Enterprises;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that any and all personnel laid-off as a result of the reduction-in-force in May, 1986, shall be given hiring preferences for available positions within the tribal government and enterprises.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
