

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to a prior Tribal Council resolution, former Acting Treasurer Edwin Kane was transferred from his position as Acting Treasurer with instructions to the Tribal Administrative Manager that Mr. Kane be assigned to a comparable position and salary; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman advises the Tribal Council that it was his understanding that Mr. Kane was not to receive a reduction in salary in his new position, but has been advised that Mr. Kane's wages were reduced by \$2,000.00 after his transfer to Apache Enterprise; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that this is contrary to the recommendation of the Office of the Chairman; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to the Tribal Council by the Tribal Chairman that Mr. Kane's salary should be restored as originally recommended.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby restores Mr. Edwin Kane's salary in the amount of \$2,000.00 as originally recommended.


The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of FIVE for and FOUR against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
