
RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by prior Council resolution accepted the voluntary reduction in pay of Council Members Darvin Burnette and Nelson Ethelbah; and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that such voluntary action by Council Members Burnette and Ethelbah is commendable but is not necessary and Council Members Burnette and Ethelbah have expressed a willingness to accept a return to their previous rate of pay and to accept a reimbursement of the funds withheld pursuant to their voluntary reduction in pay.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Council Members Nelson Ethelbah and Darvin Burnette are hereby returned to their previous rates of pay and shall be reimbursed those funds which were withheld pursuant to their voluntary reduction in pay.

The foregoing resolution was on DECEMBER 15, 1986, duly adopted by a vote of TEN FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Seciton 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of Juen 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
