

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Dr. Jeff Reid from the Archaeology Department of the University of Arizona, acting on behalf of the Arizona State Museum has presented an offer from the museum to donate to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, four 5' x 4' panels depicting ancient Indian culture of the Mogollon Rim; and

WHEREAS, the four panels were previously exhibited at the Arizona State Museum and are presently being offered to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Museum; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appreciates the offer of donation and hereby accepts the four panels for display in the tribal museum.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby formally accepts the four illustrative panels from the Arizona State Museum and further expresses its appreciation to Dr. Reid and the Arizona State Museum for this donation to the Tribal Museum.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i,j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
