## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Dr. Jeff Reid of the University of Arizona Archaeology Department has requested that the Tribal Council grant permission to him and University of Arizona to conduct the 1987 Summer Field School at Grasshopper; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Reid has conducted the Summer Field School at Grasshopper for many years in a manner satisfactory to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Dr. Reid's study should be allowed to continue.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Dr. Jeff Reid and the University of Arizona to conduct the 1987 Summer Field School at Grasshopper.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Dr. Reid to advise the Tribal Game and Fish Enterprise of the names of all persons participating in the 1987 Grasshopper study prior to commencing activities at the Grasshopper site.

The foregoing Resolution No. 01-87-05 was on January 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
