## RESOLUTION OF THE . WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Council Member Phillip Stago, Jr. suggests to the Tribal Council that the Tribal Travel Regulations be updated to reflect present costs of food and lodging in cities frequently visited such as Washington, D.C., for tribal business purposes; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Stago suggests that the Travel Regulations, although well drafted, are in need of revision to reflect the higher cost of travel since the regulations were adopted several years ago; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Milfred Cosen, Director of Business Operations, and Ray Potter, Tribal Controller, should review and make recommendations to the Tribal Council for revision of the Tribal Travel Regulations.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby instructs Milfred Cosen, Director of Business Operations and Ray Potter, Tribal Controller, to review the current Tribal Travel Regulations and report back to the Tribal council their recommendations for revision of said regulations in view of Mr. Stago's suggestions above.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
