

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Council Member, Judy Dehose, advises the Tribal Council that tribal members residing in Cibecue have voiced complaints to her pertaining to roads being torn up due to construction by a local contractor in the area; and

WHEREAS, the identity of the contractor is not certain, but residents in Cibecue are requesting Tribal Council assistance so that these roads will be repaired; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with said request and a suggestion that Mr. Vic Byerly from IHS, a member of the Tribe's Engineering Department, and Director of the Apache Labor Relations Office contact Mrs. Dehose to determine the exact location of the roads in need of repair caused by the construction activities of the local contractor operating in the area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that Mr. Vic Byerly, a member of the Tribe's Engineering Department and the Director of the Apache Labor Relations Office, contact Mrs. Judy Dehose to determine the location of the roads which are reported to be in need of repair due to construction activities by a local contractor operating in the Cibecue area.

The foregoing resolution was on January 15, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
