- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Diamond Creek.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Walter and Peggy Sanchez, Sponsors, and Leon and Faye Steele, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Donna Sanchez during the weekend of June 19, 20, 21, 1987, in Diamond Creek.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(g)&(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
