- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to Resolution No. 01-87-07, granted approval to Mr. and Mrs. Ronnie Lupe to sponsor a Sunrise Dance for Carma Jean Lupe; and
- WHEREAS, said Resolution inadvertently identified Carma Jean Lupe as Mr. and Mrs. Lupe's daughter wherein she is their granddaughter; and
- WHEREAS, the prior Resolution should be amended accordingly.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves an amendment to Resolution No. 01-87-07 to properly identify Carma Jean Lupe as Mr. and Mrs. Ronnie Lupe's granddaughter.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g,i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
