RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Mr. Greenly Fall requests that his house be moved approximately 50 feet for reasons presented; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that eight other homes in the communities of Cibecue, East Fork and Whiteriver, have also been requested to be moved by their occupants and owners; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Justin Williams, manager of the Tribal Farm Program, has been providing house moving services, but requires a Tribal Council Resolution prior to initiating the moving of any tribal house; and
- WHERFAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the request of the tribal members should be granted and that Mr. Justin Williams should be requested to move the houses to a location determined by their owners.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. Greenly Fall to have his home moved to a location of his choice.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests Mr. Justin Williams, Farm Program Manager, to move all of the homes named in the attached list, with Mr. Greenly Fall's home being moved first, prior to the onset of spring farming demands upon his program.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
