

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESEPVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Reverend Arthur Guenther of the Lutheran Church that Resolution No. 77-28 incorrectly revoked the upper Cibecue Lutheran Church lease site, rather than the lower Cibecue Church lease site; and

WHEREAS, the upper Cibecue church lease site is still in use today; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Resolution No. 77-28 should be corrected to properly designate that the lower Cibecue site was revoked, rather than the upper Cibecue lease site.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 77-28 to reflect that the lower Cibecue church site was revoked, rather than the upper Cibecue church site.

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
