## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised by the Tribal Planner and the Tribal Engineering Department that Grant applications have been submitted to the Economic Development Administration requesting funds for the renovation of the existing restaurant and motel complex at Hondah; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Planner and the Engineer Department have received preliminary approval of the grant application and expect formal approval in the near future and therefore are in the process of planning the administration of the grant funds; and
- WHEREAS, the construction contemplated by the Grant application must, pursuant to grant requirements, be advertised for either open public bidding or Indian preference bidding; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the Grant Project should be advertised pursuant to the Tribe's policy of Indian preference.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Planner and the Tribal Engineering Department to arrange for bidding of the above referenced project pursuant to the Tribe's policy of Indian preference.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>APRIL 1, 1987</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>NINE FOR AND ZERO AGAINST</u> by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
