

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that Flora Cobb, a tribal member residing in East Fork, does not have water and sewer facilities to her home; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that Flora Cobb was to be included in a prior Memorandum of Understanding with the Indian Health Service, but that inadvertently IHS failed to complete the water and sewer hookup to her home; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it is the responsibility of IHS to provide water and sewer facilities to the home of Flora Cobb, and to arrange for funding to pay for said water and sewer facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Indian Health Service to provide water and sewer hookup facilities to the home of Flora Cobb in East Fork.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Indian Health Service is to report to the office of the Tribal Chairman when said water and sewer hookup facilities can be completed for Flora Cobb.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
