FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tom and Elaine Narcisco have requested approval of the Tribal Council for them to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for their daughter during the weekend of May 1, 2, 1987; and


WHEREAS, Cecil and Myrtle Ivins have already been chosen and they have officially accepted their role of Godparents; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Cibecue.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Tom and Elaine Narcisco, Sponsors, and Cecil and Myrtle Ivins, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of May 1, 2, 1987, at Cibecue.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 28, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
