RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received numerous complaints from tribal members respecting the personnel hiring and/or firing practices and procedures of the Indian Health Service and BIA; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that there may be inappropriate conduct within the IHS and BIA personnel offices which is resulting in unfair treatment for tribal members who are employees or employee applicants of those two federal agencies.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Chairman to investigate problems associated within the IHS and BIA personnel offices regarding hiring or firing procedures of tribal members.

The foregoing resolution was on April 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
