

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman recommends to the Tribal Council that the annual salary of the Tribal Council Secretary be adjusted in acknowledgement of the excellent accomplishments that she has achieved in performing her responsibilities during the last year; and

WHEREAS, each member of the Tribal Council has voiced his or her support of a salary adjustment; and


WHEREAS, it is recommended that the salary of the Tribal Council Secretary be adjusted upwards in the amount of \$2,000 in recognition of her accomplishments and increased responsibilities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the adjustment of the Tribal Council Secretary's salary by increasing the same in the amount of \$2,000 per annum in recognition of her achievements, the additional responsibilities of said office, and in recognition of the hundreds of uncompensated hours which the Tribal Council Secretary has devoted to the expanded responsibilities of said position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said salary adjustment shall be effective May 1, 1987.

The foregoing resolution was on April 21, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
