RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there are many outstanding requests by tribal members to have their homes moved to different locations for various reasons; and
- WHEREAS, the Farm Coop. Program in the past has taken upon the responsibility to move homes upon request; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that several requests to have homes moved are several months old and requests are seriously backlogged; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Raymond Wright, an employee of the Farm Coop., has expressed a willingness to take on the responsibility of moving homes to reduce the backlog of moving requests; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Wright would be the appropriate person to take over the responsibilities of moving tribal homes, and that he should be authorized by the Tribal Council to do so.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates and authorizes Mr. Raymond Wright to take over the responsibilities of moving tribal homes.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that details as to how the house moving service should be established and administered shall be determined by the Tribal Chairman and Tribal Controller's Office.

The foregoing resolution was on April 21, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
