RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, All Tribal Programs are expected to pay the full and indirect cost rate, as negotiated between the tribe and the office of the inspector general; and
- WHEREAS, in order to waive payment of these indirect costs, the program director must appear before the Tribal Council for its approval; and
- WHEREAS, no raises to program employees shall be approved if the indirect costs have not been paid for the prior year and current year, or until those deficits have been corrected;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all program directors must appear before the Tribal Council for approval of any request to waive payment of indirect costs as negotiated between the tribe and the Office of Inspector General.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that no raises to program employees shall be approved if the indirect costs have not been paid for the prior year and the current year, or until those deficits have been paid.

The foregoing resolution was on April 22, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
