RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the fiscal year for the White Mountain Apache Tribe commences May 1, and terminates on April 30 of the subsequent year; and
- WHEREAS, timely preparation of tribal budgets is necessary to avoid delays in approving fiscal year budgets; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that all budgets must be presented by the Controller's Office with an annual financial plan for the fiscal year on or before March 31, and that said budget must be balanced on a consolidated cash flow basis.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of the Tribal Controller to prepare the tribal budgets and an annual financial plan for the fiscal year on or before March 31 of the preceding fiscal year; and further directs that said budgets be balanced on a consolidated cash flow basis.

The foregoing resolution was on April 22, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
