## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has approved a budget for FY 87/88 for Central Tribe and the Tribal Enterprises effective May 1, 1987; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Budget for FY 87/88 must be approved by the Secretary of the Interior or his authorized representative pursuant to the requirements of the Tribal Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, pending Secretarial review and approval of said budget, it is necessary that the Tribal Council authorize a continuing resolution to continue operations under the FY 86/87 budget until the Tribal Budget is approved by the BIA.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes all Tribal Enterprises and Departments to operate pursuant to the Tribal FY 86/87 budget, pending review and final approval of the FY 87/88 Budget by the Secretary of the Interior.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that no enterprise manager or tribal department director within Central Tribe shall order or purchase any capital items without the prior approval of the Tribal Chairman and Tribal Controller, and that if any capital items to be purchased are motor vehicles, that three written bids must be obtained prior to submitting a vehicle purchase request to the Tribal Chairman and Comptroller.

The foregoing resolution was on April 22, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
