## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Whiteriver American Legion Post has by previous tribal council resolution been granted financial support in the amount of \$5,000 from the tribe's revenue sharing account; and
- WHEREAS, the American Legion Post has complied with the requirements of the revenue sharing program and has held its final meeting and has received public approval for allocation and utilization of the funding; and
- WHEREAS, the American Legion is now before the Tribal Council requesting final permission to utilize the revenue sharing funds and the Tribal Council is of the opinion that permission should be granted.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Whiteriver American Legion Post is hereby authorized to expend the \$5,000 which has been previously allocated by Tribal Council Resolution No. 01-87-01.

The foregoing resolution was on May 6, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
