RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Reverend Arthur Guenther of the Lutheran Church has advised the Tribal Council that all of the Lutheran Church land leases on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation have expired and are in need of renewal; and
- WHEREAS, Reverend Guenther has advised the Tribal Council of the location of the Lutheran Church land leaseholds; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with Reverend Guenther's request that the land leases be approved for ten years effective this date, rather than having staggered termination dates.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby renews all of the Luthern Church land leases for a term of ten years, effective this date, April 1, 1987.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the office of the Tribal Attorney to draft the renewal leases or revocable permits for the Lutheran Church leaseholds in conformity with federal and tribal law.

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ONE</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (e,i,m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
