

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that reports have been received from employees working on the current HUD Housing Projects, stating that the Project Architects Inspector, Lyle Chambers, has been approving substandard construction; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned that Mr. Chambers, who is the personal representative of the architect, Lou Weller, may not be performing his inspection duties in a responsible and professional manner; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Board of Commissioners for the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority and Housing Authority Director, Victor Velasquez, should investigate these charges of lenient inspection of substandard construction on the on-going HUD Housing Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requests that Councilmember Herbert Tate act as liaison with the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners and Mr. Velasquez, and arrange for a neutral party experienced in construction to provide an impartial opinion in respect to allegations that Mr. Lyle Chambers has approved substandard construction.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the White Mountain Apache Housing Board of Commissioners and Housing Authority Director, Victor Velasquez, meet and confer with Councilmember Herbert Tate in respect to allegations that the architect's inspector, Mr. Lyle Chambers, is approving substandard quality construction on the on-going HUD Housing Projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests that Mr. Victor Velasquez report back to the Tribal Council as soon as the investigation is complete in respect to these allegations.

The foregoing resolution was on May 13, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a) of the Amended

Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
