RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Recreation Enterprise which is in charge of the promulgation and enforcement of Game & Fish Regulations, has proposed a schedule of restitution fees to be paid by violators of Tribal Game & Fish Laws; and
- WHEREAS, a copy of said proposed restitution schedule is attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in the recommendation of the Manager of the Game & Fish Department that the schedule of restitution fees should be formally adopted by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, thereby amending and superceding the previous schedule of restitution fees in effect FY 86/87.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby adopts and enacts the attached schedule of restitution fees for FY 87/88, effective this date.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the manager of the Recreation Enterprise to amend all Game & Fish Regulations and pamphlets to reflect the amendment to the restitution schedule.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
