WHEREAS, Assistant Safety Director, Darvin Burnette, has requested training funds in the amount of \$130.00 to conduct fire extinguisher operation training for tribal enterprise and departmental personnel; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in this request; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman's Office has offered to fund the \$130.00 from the Tribal Chairman's budget.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to expend \$130.00 from his budget in order to fund a training session for tribal department and enterprise personnel in the use of fire extinguishers.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
