WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has contracted with the Bureau of Indian Affairs under Public Law 93-638 for the Judicial Services Program; and


WHEREAS, each year the Bureau of Indian Affairs requires a tribal resolution to recontract; and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to recontract for FY 88.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorize and reapplies for the Judicial Services 638 Contract for Fiscal Year 1988.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Chairman or his designate representative is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents requested to consummate this contract.

The foregoing resolution was on June 24, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of SIX for and TWO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
