RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe considers the education of its children to be of the utmost importance and one of the Tribe's highest priorities; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council by previous Tribal Resolution Number 83-207 empowered the Cibecue Community Education Board, Inc. to contract all or parts of the total operation of the Cibecue Community School; and

WHEREAS, the Cibecue Community School has successfully operated the educational program for the past three years and is currently providing quality education to the two-hundred six (206) students enrolled at the school.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Cibecue Community Education Board, Inc. is hereby authorized to enter into a three year contract for the operation of the Cibecue Community School in the approximate amount of \$800,000 to commence on July 1, 1987, or as soon thereafter as a suitable contract can be negotiated with an expiration date of this authority not later than September 30, 1990;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that during the period of this three year contract, the Cibecue Community Education Board, Inc. is authorized to negotiate, contract and amend other educationally related contracts and grants necessary for the successful operation of the Cibecue Community School, including but are not limited to: Chapter I, Exceptional Education, Title IV-A, Title VII and School Drug and Alcohol services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Cibecue Community Education Board, Inc. is authorized to negotiate and execute this contract and any amendments thereof.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 8, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
