

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the Tribe's governing body; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is committed to the delivery of Social Services to its tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to recontract Social Services from the Bureau of Indian Affairs as provided under 93-638, the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act; and
- WHEREAS, the services provided within this contract shall include, General Assistance; Child Welfare Assistance; Miscellaneous Assistance; the Tribal Work Experience Program and Family and Community Services, and Custodial Care for Adults; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to recontract for Social Services for a period of one (1) year beginning with the Federal Fiscal Year on October 1, 1987 and continuing through September 30, 1988; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council further desires to authorize the Tribal Chairman or his designated representative to negotiate such contract and/or amendments.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the submission of a proposal to recontract Social Services to provide ongoing services to members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for a period of one year for FY 87/88.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs make every effort to appropriate sufficient funds to minimize the Tribe's financial contribution to the program, including the appropriation of sufficient funds to carry the mandated 18.3% indirect cost rate to be applied to all such contracts.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract and/or any amendments to consummate this contract on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 23, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
