FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member, Felix Riley, has come before the Tribal Council and requested approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for his daughter on August 15, 1987; and


WHEREAS, Tennyson and Dollie Victor have been chosen and they have officially accepted the role of Godparents; and

WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the ceremonial activity to be held in Rainbow City.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Felix and June Riley, Sponsors, and Tennyson and Dollie Victor, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Felicia Riley on August 15, 1987, in Rainbow City.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 5, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984).
