## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Beatrice Joe, has come before the Tribal Council and requested a homesite in Whiteriver, located southwest of the Vocational Skill Center; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Joe informs the Tribal Council that she has approached the Tribal Land Board and requested their approval of her homesite application and the Land Board has referred Ms. Joe to the Tribal Council for final approval of her application; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the request of Ms. Joe and is of the opinion that the homesite should be granted in accordance with the application submitted by Ms. Joe to the Tribal Land Board.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the application for a homesite submitted by Ms. Beatrice Joe to the Tribal Land Board is hereby approved and a homesite is granted.

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
