

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. Wilkie Gregg, Sr., Committee Chairman of the Tribal Forestry Committee, has come before the Tribal Council and requested that additional members be appointed to the Forestry Committee in order to address the issues regarding the Tribe's forest resource; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the list of candidates submitted by Mr. Gregg and has added to that list other names, and has voted on the proposed membership of the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has voted to select the following individuals to serve on the Forestry Committee: Raymus Albert, Vernell Gatewood, Lane Endfield, and Broadus Bones, with George Ivins selected as an alternate. The Tribal Council has also selected Mr. Scott Canty to serve as an ex-officio non-voting member, acting as the legal advisor to the Forestry Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in addition to Mr. Wilkie Gregg who currently serves on the Forestry Committee, the following individuals are hereby appointed to serve on that committee: Raymus Albert, Vernell Gatewood, Lane Endfield, Broadus Bones, and George Ivins as an alternate. Scott Canty of the Tribal Attorney's Office will serve as an ex-officio non-voting member and act as legal advisor to the Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(f),(i),(s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
