## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the Tribal Council has been advised by the Tribal WHEREAS, Election Commission that there is a need to revise Tribal Election Chapter, Chapter Three, Section 3.2 of the Government Code in order to provide for voter registration procedures and to clarify the procedure for registering and voting in tribal elections; and
- a proposed amendment to Chapter Three, Section 3.2 of WHEREAS, the Government Code has been presented to the Tribal Council and has been found to be acceptable by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Government Code, Chapter Three, Section 3.2 is hereby amended by the enactment of Ordinance No. 155, a copy of which is attached hereto.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council Secretary is hereby directed to post said ordinance for ten (10) days as required by the Tribal Constitution and Bylaws.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1987, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VIII, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
