## PESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIPE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has by Resolution No. 08-87-252 provided for the transfer of Ram Earth Project funds to the HIP Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Housing shortage on the reservation is very acute in Districts I and II, Cibecue and Carrizo; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the Ram Earth funds which have been transferred to the HIP Program should be equally utilized in Districts I and II for the provision of tribal housing.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ms. Beverly Stago, Director of the HIP Housing Program, is hereby directed to allocate the Ram Earth funds which have been transferred to the HIP Program, equally between Districts I and II.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and TWO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a), (j), (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
