- WHEREAS, Mr. Raymus Albert has come before the Tribal Council and has reviewed the minutes of the Tribal Land Board meetings of July 10, 17, 24, 26, 31, 1987; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the minutes of these meetings are appropriate and should be accepted and the actions taken by the Land Board approved; including the granting of tribal member homesites.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the minutes of the Land Board meeting minutes of July 10, 17, 24, 26, 31, 1987, and approves the actions taken thereby, including the granting of tribal member homesites.

The foregoing resolution was on AUGUST 6, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN FOR AND ZERO AGAINST by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984).
