RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the local American Legion Post #60 has requested financial assistance from the Tribal Council for the payment of past due utility bills, and other bills arising from the operation and maintenance of the Post #60 building and the work of the American Legion Association; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the total amount of money necessary to meet the past and present obligations of American Legion Post #60 is approximately \$5,000.00; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to recognize the tribal members who comprise the membership of the local American Legion Post #60, a non-profit, unincorporated association of veterans of foreign wars, who have served the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the United States of America.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the donation of \$5,000.00 in tribal funds to the American Legion Post #60.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Controller to locate a source of funds within the approved tribal budget and donate said monies in accordance with this resolution, after first identifying the source of the funds to the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on August 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
