## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by previous Council Resolution No. 08-87-266, acted to amend Tribal Ordinance No. 120 (the Tribal Peddler's Ordinance) to provide for increased fee assessments; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council Secretary was directed by that resolution to post said amendment for a minimum of ten days in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal Constitution, and the Council's directive to post the amendment for the minimum 10-day period has been complied with; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to grant its final approval to this amendment of Tribal Ordinance No. 120.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts into law the provisions of Tribal Ordinance No. 120 as amended.

The foregoing resolution was on September 1, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a & o) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
