FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman has advised the Council that there is a need to appoint a new standing Queen Committee to coordinate and carry out all activities during the 1987/88 reign of Miss White Mountain Apache, Christine Tortice, and has proposed the following individuals to the Tribal Council for appointment to that committee: Bernita Danford as Chairperson; Evalina Hinton, Denise Williams, Peggy Riley, Joanna Hinton, Irene Alsenay Casa, Eva Hoffman Thomas, and Judy Armstrong; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after review of the Chairman's recommendations, concurs in the same and desires to appoint the above-listed individuals to the Tribal Queen Committee for the 1987/88 year.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following individuals are hereby appointed to serve on the 1987/88 Queen Committee: Bernita Danford as Chairperson; Evalina Hinton, Denise Williams, Peggy Riley, Joanna Hinton, Irene Alsenay Casa, Eva Hoffman Thomas, and Judy Armstrong.

The foregoing resolution was on September 1, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ONE against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(a&s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
