RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way WHEREAS, 100 feet in width for a distance of 11.82 miles in length for access road FAIR 12 (20) from Cibecue to Grasshopper as filed in the Office of the Superintendent of Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona;
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs the gratuitous right-of-way as referenced herein and as recorded on file in the Office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the White Mountain Arache Tribal Council that it hereby requests that 11.82 miles be added to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Reservation Road System and grants the Bureau of Indian Affairs and any contractors with the Bureau of Indian Affairs the right to enter upon Tribal lands for the purpose of surveying, environmental, archaeological, and soil investigations and any other activities of developing, planning, construction, designing, and maintaining said highway construction project.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) & (g) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
