- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the Whiteriver Fairgrounds.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Gibson and Diana Aday, Sponsors, and Mr. & Mrs. Herman Smith, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Sinafeofiliava Aday during the weekend of June 24 & 25, 1988, at the Whiteriver Fairgrounds.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (g) (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
