RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the Tribal Treasurer, Lloyd Susan, has advised the WHEREAS, Tribal Council that the Treasurer's Office direct control of various accounting procedures and that it is therefore necessary for the Treasurer's Office to purchase a computer system in order to provide immediate immediate access to data and allow financial for the monitoring of the day to day transactions of the tribal enterprises; and
- the type and the Tribal Treasurer has determined WHEREAS, provide this quality of equipment necessary to function in the treasurer's office and a description of the equipment and its estimated price is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
- the Tribal Treasurer has advised the Tribal Council WHEREAS, that sufficient funds are available in the Treasurer's budget for this fiscal year to purchase this computer equipment and the Treasurer requires authorization this Council to make Tribal the expenditure; and
- the Tribal Council is in agreement with the Tribal WHEREAS, Treasurer that a computer system is necessary to assist the Treasurer's Office in the performance of its duties as delegated by the Tribal Council.
- that the Tribal Council hereby autho-THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED rizes the Tribal Treasurer to expend necessary funds from the Treasurer's existing budget for the purchase of computer equipment in accordance with the estimated prices established by Exhibit A attached hereto.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
