RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Lula Ann Ivins has advised the Tribal Council that her husband, George Ivins, has been assessed additional taxes and penalties for 1986 by the United States Internal Revenue Service (IRS); and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Ivins has requested assistance from the Tribal Council in resolving this matter and the Tribal Council concurs that assistance should be rendered.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Attorney's Office is hereby directed to assist Mr. and Mrs. Ivins in the resolution of their dispute with the Internal Revenue Service.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of ELEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
