

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the family of tribal member Samson Smith has advised the Tribal Council that Mr. Smith is handicapped and in critical need of a home; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Smith does not qualify for HUD Housing or HIP Housing and is therefore without recourse and has asked the Tribal Council for assistance; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe owns several small cabins at Hawley Lake which can be relocated and utilized as an individual residence; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been vested with authority pursuant to the constitution and bylaws of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to dispose of tribal property in the best interest of the tribe.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that one of the small 20'x 10' cabins located at Hawley Lake is hereby donated by the Tribe to Mr. Samson Smith for his use as an individual residence. Mr. Smith should make arrangements to have the home moved from the Hawley Lake Area to his designated homesite.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) & (b) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
