## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane has requested an appropriation of Land Claim monies from the Carrizo Land Claim funds in order to purchase batteries and for payment of the Labor and installation of the batteries at the Carrizo T.V. Antenna for the benefit of tribal members living in the Carrizo Community; and

WHEREAS, an itemized list marked Exhibit A is attached to this resolution and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with this request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants approval for the appropriation of Carrizo Land Claims monies in the amount of Four Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$416.00) for the purchase of batteries and labor for the Carrizo T.V. Antenna according to Exhibit A attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) & (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
