- WHEREAS, Rudy and Cora Walker have been chosen and have accepted the role of Godparents; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are currently underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the old tribal fair grounds in Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Darrell and Joyce (Johnson) Amarok, Sponsors, and Mr. & Mrs. Rudy Walker, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance for Mercy Amarok during the weekend of July 1-4, 1988, at the old tribal fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on December 2, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Nountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) & (g) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
