## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN ARACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the recent resignation of the Tribal Farm Manager has created the need to fill the Farm Manager Position; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has solicited applications and from those applications has selected one individual who possesses the qualifications necessary to profitably manage the tribal farm; and
- WHEREAS, upon an interview, Mr. Claude Face has exhibited an ability to assume managerial responsibility for the farm operation and has expressed his willingness to assume responsibilities for management of the farm; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that Mr. Pace is qualified and should be given the job of tribal farm manager.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Claude Pace is hereby appointed Manager of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Farm effective this date.

The foregoing resolution was on December 7, 1987, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and TWO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) & (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
