RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has the inherent and constitutional authority to recognize persons as enrolled tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council Secretary has reviewed the attached list (Ex. A.) of potential members; and
- WHEREAS, it appears that the persons whose names are on the list have met all the legal requirements to become enrolled members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the persons whose names appear on the attached Exhibit A are hereby enrolled as members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) & (p) and Article III of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
