- WHEREAS, plans are already underway for Mr. and Mrs. Lonnie Dehose to hold a Sunrise Dance during the weekend of July 4th, 1988, at Cibecue. The god-parents, Chuck and Geraldine Pike, have accepted their role to be the co-sponsors of the ceremonial dance.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. and Mrs. Lonnie Dehose will sponsor a traditional Sunrise Ceremony at Cibecue during the weekend of July 4, 1988, for their grand daughter.

The foregoing resolution was on February 19, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article v, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of teh tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
