RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member, Annette Lupe Antonio has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council a problem with her homesite application; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to meet the needs of its tribal members.
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Annette Lupe Antonio is hereby granted a homesite in the Knotts Landing Community as more particularly described on the attached Exhibit A and as designated in application for land assignment form #403208.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1988, duly adopted by a vote of <u>TEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
